Smith's Asks Customers to Check Freezers at Home for Beef Products Recalled Due to Possible Health Risk

We have been informed by JBS Swift Beef Co. of an expansion to their June 24 recall that includes additional beef products that may be contaminated with *E. coli* O157:H7.

Smith's Food and Drug Stores is asking customers to carefully check their freezers at home for select store-brand and store-packaged ground beef with sell-by dates from April 27 to June 1, 2009.

These items include beef products in foam tray packages wrapped in clear cellophane and purchased at Smith's in-store fresh meat cases.
